The purpose of the association SPT

The purpose of the association SPT is to function as a link between experts representing the authorities, industry, research institutions, and associations in the areas of safety and security technology, rescue and civil defence, and in the fields of protection from toxic industrial chemicals and chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear, and explosive (CBRNE) materials and weapons.

Activities

The association organises national and international events for the public and for the experts, visits to various places of interest for its members, symposia and training events, and publishes in the areas of its interests. In addition, the association promotes collaboration and networking both nationally and internationally between its members and people active in the field.

The association organises the tri-annual international NBC symposia in Finland. These symposia provide an interdisciplinary forum for discussions on issues related to protection against CBRN threats, and improvised explosive devices for decision makers, experts, professionals, security and safety officers, military planners and scientists.

Grants and stipends

The association awards minor grants and stipends for research, conference trips or thesis work.

A short history

The association was registered on July 26, 2010. The association has continued the activities of the Section for NBC Protection, Rescue and Civil Defence, that was established in 1996 as a section under the Association of Finnish Chemical Societies.

Members

Any person representing the fields of protection, rescue, and security and competencies associated with these fields is eligible to apply for ordinary membership in the association. Also students may apply for membership. Legally competent societies may become supportive members.

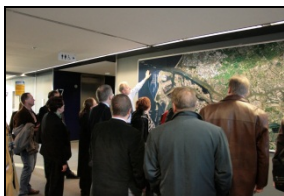
